are prepared to meet the requirements and expectations of today's

employers.

**Survey Respondents:** For the 2018 and 2020 administrations, Principals from all public schools in

Chester and Delaware Counties and select public schools in Philadelphia

County.

For the 2021 administration, Principals and Assistant Principals from all public schools in Chester and Delaware Counties and select public schools in

Philadelphia County.

Survey Type: Proprietary (Skyfactor Benchworks)

**Administration Type:** Online

Minimum Acceptable

**Level of Expectations:** For questions 1-19, the minimum is a rating of 5.

For question 20, the minimum is a rating of "About as prepared as others."

#### **Key Findings**

Employers are extremely (a rating of 6 or 7) satisfied with the overall performance of recent graduates from our educator preparation programs. (Source: Question 18)

- Employers are extremely (a rating of 6 or 7) likely to recommend their schools hire graduates from our educator preparation programs. (Source: Question 19)
- ❖ Employers believe our recent graduates are "Better prepared than others" or "Among the best prepared" in comparison to other recent hires with similar levels of education and experience who are not our graduates. (Source: Question 20)
- Most employers consistently meet our minimum acceptable level of expectations in their ratings. However, two areas for improvement could involve improving employers' satisfaction with recent graduates regarding their:
  - written communication skills, and (Source: Question 5)
  - ➤ ability to exhibit a mastery of relevant content. (Source: Question 15)
