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Overview & Key Findings

The following provides contextual information regarding the administration of the Employer Survey for Initial and Advanced-Level educator preparation programs at West Chester University of Pennsylvania.

Purpose:	The Employer Survey is administered to employers of alumni to measure their satisfaction with the preparation of program completers. Additionally, these data are used to improve our programs to ensure program completers are prepared to meet the requirements and expectations of today's employers.
Survey Respondents:	Principals and Assistant Principals from all public schools in Chester and Delaware Counties and select public schools in Philadelphia County.
Survey Type:	Proprietary (Skyfactor Benchworks)
Administration Type:	Online
Administration Dates:	January 18, 2022 – February 11, 2022
Response Rate:	4.9% (19 out of 384 total survey participants)
Minimum Acceptable Level of Expectations:	For questions 1-19, the minimum is a rating of 5. For question 20, the minimum is a rating of "About as prepared as others."

Key Findings

- ✤ 84% of employers are extremely (a rating of 6 or 7) satisfied with the overall performance of recent graduates from our educator preparation programs. (Source: Question 18)
- 95% of employers are extremely (a rating of 6 or 7) likely to recommend their schools hire graduates from our educator preparation programs. (Source: Question 19)
- ✤ 79% of employers believe our recent graduates are "Better prepared than others" or "Among the best prepared" in comparison to other recent hires with similar levels of education and experience who are not our graduates. (Source: Question 20)
- ✤ 67% of employers are extremely (a rating of 6 or 7) satisfied with recent graduates regarding their ability to exhibit a mastery of relevant content. (Source: Question 15)
