Data Disaggregation Notes:	Data are not displayed for programs or prompts with less than 10 responses. The Educator Preparation Provider level data is disaggregated by gender. The data displays results by "Female" and "Male." Data displays for respondents who selected "Transgender" (N=0), "Other" (N=0), or "Prefer Not to Answer" (N=2) are not included because of the low number of respondents. The Educator Preparation Provider level data is disaggregated by race/ethnicity. The data displays results by "White" and "All Other Races/Ethnicities." The first category includes respondents who selected only "White" and no other race/ethnicity. The second category includes "Asian," "Black or African American," "Hispanic or Latino," "American Indian or Alaska Native," "Native Hawaiian or Other Pacific Islander," and "Other." Additionally, if a respondent selected "White" and another race/ethnicity, they were included in the second category. A data display for respondents who did not provide a response (N=1) or selected "Prefer Not to Answer" (N=2) is not included because of the low number of respondents.
